Ingles Group breaks ground at Coomera, again.

Ingles Group has started work on the \$30 million, 72-home second stage of its Coomera Parklands project.

The start of works at the Finnegans Way site comes only weeks after breaking ground on its flagship, \$500 million, 850-dwelling, Big Sky residential community.

Ingles Group managing director Graeme Ingles said the move showed the level of confidence that the Ingles Group had in the future of Coomera.

“We have already committed to the start of Big Sky and now we are pushing on with the second stage of Coomera Parklands,” said Mr Ingles.

“I have no doubt that the future of the development of the Gold Coast lies in its northern suburbs and Coomera in particular.

“The region has so much potential and we want to be a major player in the development of this important suburb of the future.”

The Finnegans Way project, being built by the Ingles Group about 1km east of the giant Coomera Town Centre site, is expected to be completed over the next two to three years.

The 10-stage Big Sky project is being developed on a 75ha site only a couple of hundred metres away from the Coomera Parklands second stage.

One of Australia’s largest privately owned developers, Ingles Group had previously earmarked another development site on the western side of the M1 to be the second stage of its popular Coomera project.

However, the Surfers Paradise-based developer has brought forward the Finnegans Way project because of timing and logistical issues.
