



Coastal influence

THE outdoor lifestyle of the Gold Coast has been the inspiration behind one of Ingles Homes' latest designs, the Azure.

Marketing director Kaye Durre said the 240sqm, four-bedroom, two-storey home was designed with a focus on entertaining and alfresco living.

Ms Durre said the Azure featured two separate outdoor relaxation areas where residents could lounge around, as well as a private balcony off the main bedroom.

"The design, which is available with two different rooflines, offers an expansive open-plan dining and entertaining space upstairs, created to link with an adjoining outdoor entertaining area," she said.

"The major entertainment precinct spans the family room, dining area and open-plan kitchen, boasting an island bench to ensure the 'in-house chef' remains part of any celebrations.

"The terrace is just off the dining room and its position provides immediate access to the kitchen."

Ms Durre said there were also three bedrooms and two bathrooms on the 132sqm second floor.

"The main bedroom has an ensuite that includes a bath, shower,

double-basin vanity and toilet," she said.

"Downstairs, which comprises 99sqm, features either a fourth bedroom or study, a third bathroom, the entry, a formal lounge and a double-car garage.

"The Azure is one of 11 designs that Ingles Homes has created for three new residential communities being developed by the Ingles Group in the Coomera region."

These include the \$500 million, 900-dwelling, Big Sky residential community, the neighbouring Coomera Parklands stage two and the boutique Saltwater project.
